A REAL PROPERTY.

The Ciccillo Matarazzo Pavilion of São Paulo Bienal Foundation was designed by architect Oscar Niemeyer. The building is a true icon of Brazilian modernist architecture, listed as a Historical Heritage site.

Niemeyer was a Brazilian architect, very well-known for modern architecture. He became established because of his designs and buildings for Brasilia in the 1950's, a city that became the country's capital in 1960. He won the Pritzker Architecture Prize in 1988, and some of his most recent projects include the Niterói Museum of Contemporary Art (1996), the Oscar Niemeyer Museum of Curitiba (2002), the Administrative City of Minas Gerais (2010), the Oscar Niemeyer International Cultural Center of Spain (2011), and the Luiz Carlos Prestes Memorial (2012 project, completed in 2017).

Oscar Niemeyer passed away on December 5, 2012.

### LANGUAGE

The official language in Brazil is Portuguese. The country does not have a second official language, and English is not widely spoken. In Sao Paulo's tourist spots, some people have a certain degree of knowledge of the language.

# WEATHER IN THE CITY OF SÃO PAULO

The city of São Paulo has an unpredictable climate. You can experience all four seasons in a single day, with colder early mornings, warm afternoons and a slight drop in temperature at the end of the day.

The temperature range can be between 11°C (52°F) and 22°C (72°F), and the temperature can be even higher, as our event is being held near the beginning of spring.

For that reason, having mid-season clothes and a light coat are a great option.

### TIME ZONE

Brazil is a country that covers a very large area, having three time zones. The city of São Paulo, however, adopts the same time as the capital, the official time called Brasília time, which is three hours behind the Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

### CURRENCY

The currency of Brazil is the Real and its exchange rate can widely vary. This variation is commonly around: • 1 U.S. dollar = 4 reais • 1 Euro = 6.6 reais

• 1 Euro = 4.4 reais

You can find currency exchange offices at the airport and in the major shopping malls across the city of São Paulo.



In addition, Visa, Mastercard and American Express credit cards are accepted at major hotels, restaurants and shopping malls.

#### ELECTRICITY AND OUTLETS

The electric voltage in the city of São Paulo is 110V, but some hotels have 220V outlets.

The Brazilian plug standard is unique and different from the rest of the world. It is the NBR 14136 plug, based on the international standard IEC 60906-1, with three pins, as you can see in the picture. Make sure your devices are compatible with the local voltage.

### MEDICAL SERVICES, EMERGENCY PHONES AND SAFETY

In Brazil, public health services also serve foreign nationals. It is known as SUS, the Unified Health System. To receive care, you must seek an Emergency Unit, known as UPA, or call the number 192 to contact the Mobile Emergency Service (SAMU). It is important, however, that you take travel health insurance.

# LEARN MORE ABOUT THE CITY

São Paulo is a city with lots and lots of attractions. To help you experience the best it has to offer, we have listed a few places for you.

#### **AVENIDA PAULISTA**

Avenida Paulista is one of the city's main financial and cultural centers, attracting thousands of visitors and tourists every day. Besides having several options of stores and restaurants, it is also home to São Paulo's most famous museum, MASP, several movie theaters, and large bookstores.

#### MASP

One of the most important museums in the Southern Hemisphere, the São Paulo Art Museum has a collection of approximately 8,000 pieces, including famous artists such as Brazil's Portinari and Anita Malfatti, and international acquisitions such as works by Picasso and Van Gogh. The building itself is an attraction. The majestic concrete structure is suspended by four red pillars, forming a 74-meter free area under the museum. <u>https://masp.org.br/</u>

#### **PINACOTECA**

Designed in 1895, the building that currently houses the State Pinacoteca was the first art museum of São Paulo. At the time, it was built to house the Lyceum of Arts and Crafts, an institution that taught technicians and craftspeople. The architecture of the museum itself is worth the visit, allowing visitors to enjoy works of art under natural lighting. <u>http://pinacoteca.org.br/</u>

#### **MUNICIPAL THEATRE**

Based on the Paris Opera, the Municipal Theatre is one of São Paulo's main attractions. Since its construction in 1903, it has undergone several restorations to modernize its facilities, but without losing the glamor of the early 1900s style. The theatre features performances by dance and music schools, and on days when there are no scheduled performances, visitors can enter the theatre to visit it. <u>https://theatromunicipal.org.br/</u>
